


Opening a google scholar account(You must have a valid gmail account)

1.Open a gmail account

2. open the google scholar website by visiting <http://scholar.google.com/>

3.you will get an interphase like this.



4. click on sign in and log in using your gmail account credentials

5.click on citations

6.You will get an interphase like this with your email top right

11.click next to step 2. Skip step if asked irrelevant query

12.click next and go to profile.You will get something like this
